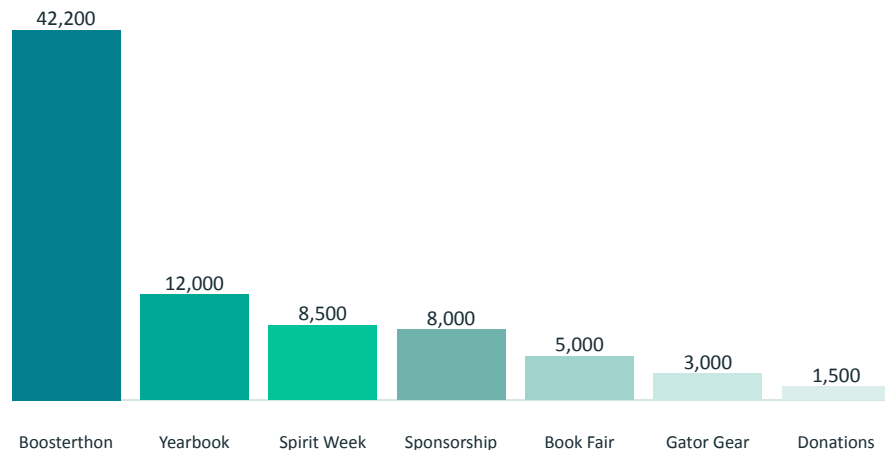

Figures from QuickBooks as of 8/18/26 (checking account; no separate savings/reserve account currently holds funds). Pending final bank reconciliation.

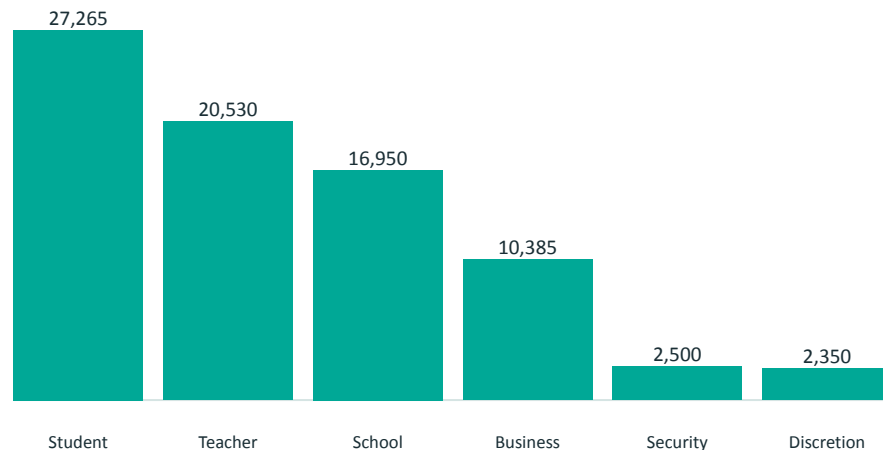


2026–2027 Budget: Income & Expenses

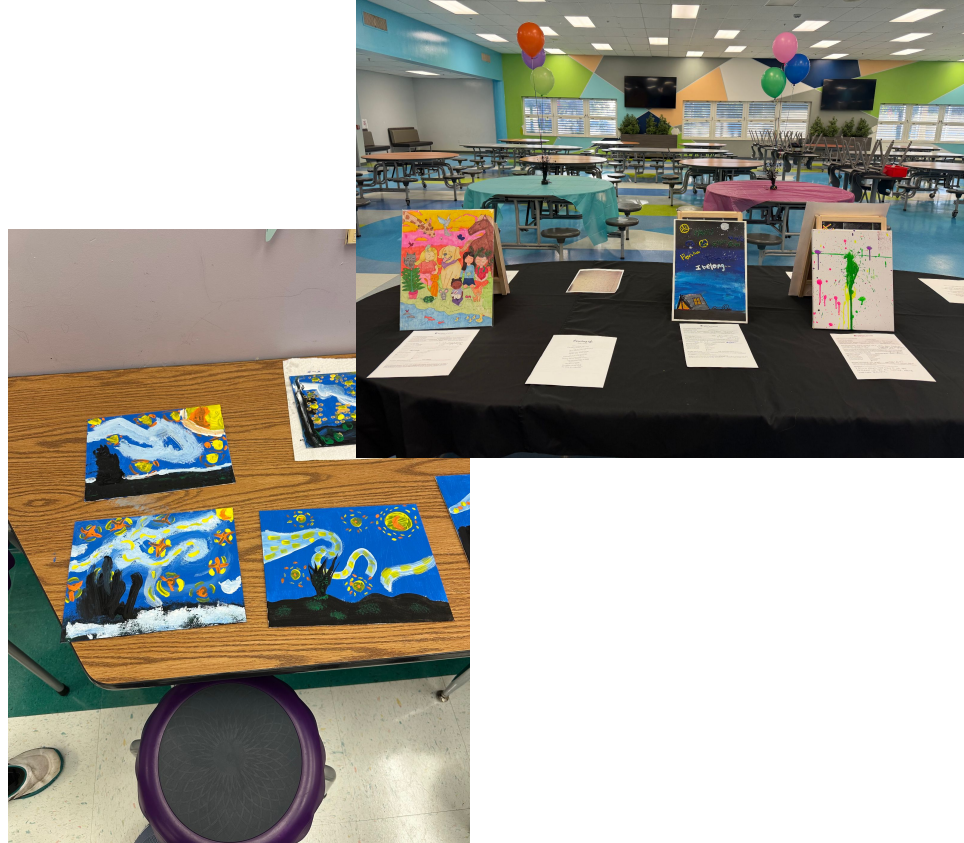

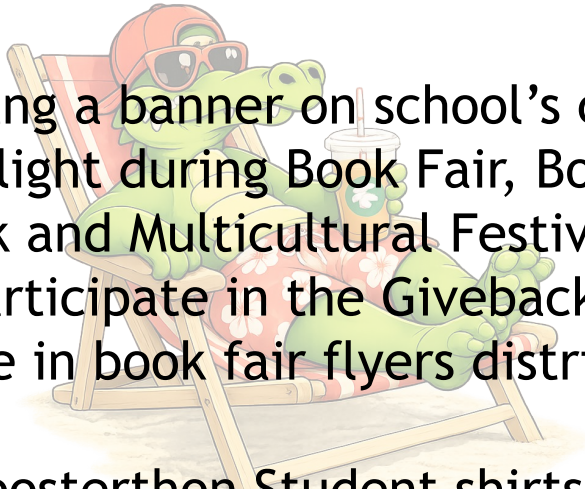
Become a Broward County Approved Volunteer

- Volunteers must report to their volunteer location and return to the front office upon completion of their event



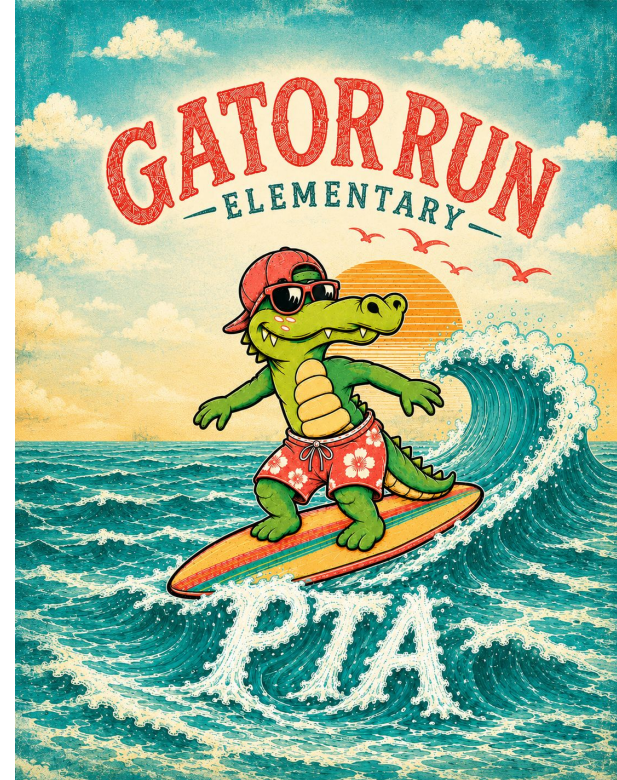
Gator Run PTA Sponsorship Program
