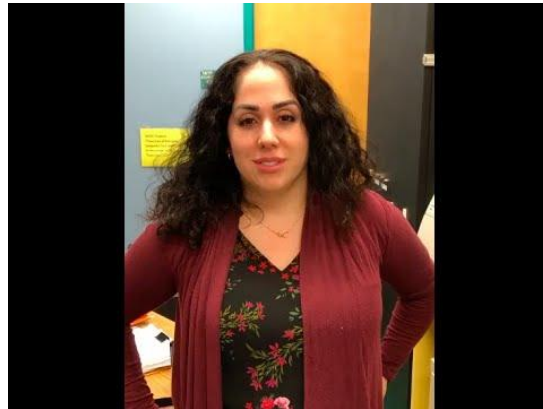

Dual Language Program

Gator Run currently has a Dual Language program.

In grades K-5

Two classes participate in this program.

Students participate in both classes with half the day being taught in English and half the day being taught in Spanish,

The program is open to both non-Spanish speakers as well as native speakers.

Applications may be picked up in the front office at GRE. Applications will be accepted until June 30, 2021.

Students will be chosen through a lottery.
